**One Word That May Kill A Dream**

**Truth #1: There are far too many voices in our world today telling us to “settle”.**

**Truth #2: There are far too few voices in our world today telling us to “Dream Big Dreams For God!”**

**I Samuel 10:1; 15:10-11a; 16:1, 13; 18:14-15; 20:1(NLT)**

**10:1**Then Samuel took a flask of olive oil and poured it over Saul's head. He kissed Saul on the cheek and said, "I am doing this because the LORD has appointed you to be the leader of his people Israel.

**15:10** Then the LORD said to Samuel, "I am sorry that I ever made Saul king, for he has not been loyal to me and has again refused to obey me." **16:1** Finally, the LORD said to Samuel, "You have mourned long enough for Saul. I have rejected him as king of Israel. Now fill your horn with olive oil and go to Bethlehem. Find a man named Jesse who lives there, for I have selected one of his sons to be my new king." **13** So as David stood there among his brothers, Samuel took the olive oil he had brought and poured it on David's head. And the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him from that day on. Then Samuel returned to Ramah. **18:14** David continued to succeed in everything he did, for the LORD was with him. **15** When Saul recognized this, he became even more afraid of him. **20:1** David now fled from Naioth in Ramah and found Jonathan. "What have I done?" he exclaimed. "What is my crime? How have I offended your father that he is so determined to kill me?"

**II Sam 5:3-4 (NLT)**

So there at Hebron, David made a covenant with the leaders of Israel before the LORD. And they anointed him king of Israel. **4** David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years in all.
